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1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

The UK Longitudinal Linkage Collaboration (UK LLC) organisation is led by the University of Bristol (UoB) and University of Edinburgh (UoE) and operated in collaboration with Swansea University, University of Leicester, St George's, University of London and UCL. UK LLC manages the collation, curation and access to de-identified data about Longitudinal Population Study (LPS) participants held in the UK LLC Trusted Research Environment (TRE).

Safeguarding the anonymity and security of participants' data held in the UK LLC TRE are of paramount importance to UK LLC. All researchers must only include data in papers/presentations that have been approved through UK LLC's output review process. (see the <u>UK LLC Output Review Policy</u> for details)

1.2 Purpose

This policy sets out UK LLC's requirements for researchers to **publish papers and similar outputs** and to **deliver presentations** based on data accessed in the UK LLC TRE.

This policy will be reviewed to respond to any changes in the UK LLC risk assessment or risk treatment plan and at least annually.

2. SCOPE

This policy applies to all researchers who have accessed data in the UK LLC TRE who want to include their analyses in any output for public dissemination. This includes:

- Papers and similar outputs, e.g. reports, books
- Presentations.

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4. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Who	What & Why
Researchers	 Only include data that are approved through UK LLC's output review process – see the <u>UK LLC Output Review Policy</u> Share all papers with UK LLC prior to submission Stay within scope of approved project and adhere to data owners' terms and conditions.
UK LLC Data Team (UoB) & Application Team (UoE)	Review all papers prior to submission.

5. RULES

- 1. All researchers must ensure that their analyses and outputs fall within the scope of their approved project and adhere to data owners' terms and conditions.
- 2. All papers and similar outputs **must be shared with UK LLC** for review prior to submission for publication.
- UK LLC does not require to see presentations before they are delivered, but researchers must acknowledge the use and funding of UK LLC's resource and the collaborative contribution of the LPS and other data owners and partners – see details in section 6.
- Contributions to papers and similar outputs should be acknowledged using <u>ICMJE</u> <u>authorship guidelines</u>. UK LLC staff, partners and contributing LPS staff are not expected to be authors unless they have provided material input and where authorship is justified under ICMJE guidelines.
- 5. Researchers should ensure papers and similar outputs are placed into the **public domain as quickly as possible.** UK LLC encourages researchers to use a preprint server such as <u>medRxiv</u> to make their outputs publicly available while formal peer review is underway.
- 6. Papers and similar outputs must be published as **Open Access** in line with <u>UKRI guidelines</u>.
- 7. UK LLC staff do not conduct peer-review or scientific assessment.
- 8. Under all circumstances **UK LLC Executive Group reserves the right to submit letters or papers for publication** in response to any paper or similar output to explain study procedures or to express an alternative scientific argument.
- 9. Datasets from UK LLC's TRE cannot be published in public databanks because the underlying data are sourced from confidential LPS data and linked routine records and can only be accessed in the TRE. Project data can be requested via UK LLC for the purposes of replication and/or scientific challenge. Where this is requested from a journal, we suggest that you provide the following statement:

'Data used in this research are made available via UK Longitudinal Linkage Collaboration (UK LLC), which is a Trusted Research Environment (TRE) developed and operated by the Universities of Bristol and Edinburgh using an underlying 'Secure eResearch Platform' provided by Swansea University. These data cannot be used or shared outside this environment. Researchers can apply to access the UK LLC TRE using

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the procedure outlined in the <u>UK LLC Data Access and Acceptable Use Policy</u>. UK LLC uses a system of managed open access for researchers who demonstrate their project is intended to improve the public good.'

6. SUPPORTING MATERIALS

It is imperative that all researchers acknowledge UK LLC and its partners, collaborators, funders and contributing data owners appropriately. To help researchers, we have prepared the following materials.

Note: the materials contain information about **all the LPS** and **other data owners** that contribute data to UK LLC's TRE – researchers should adapt the materials to **only reference the LPS and other data owners included in their outputs**.

6.1 Papers and similar outputs

See the Publication Checklist in section 7 and detailed information about LPS for the supplementary materials of publications (DOC-ISM-032) on the <u>Resources for Researchers SharePoint</u>.

6.2 **Presentations**

Materials comprise a selection of slides, including acknowledgements and logos, which are available on <u>UK LLC's GitHub</u>.

7. UK LLC PUBLICATION CHECKLIST

UK LLC has worked with all partners, including contributing LPS and other data owners, to establish the **publication checklist** detailed below for papers and similar outputs.

Researchers can access an **editable Publication Checklist** (DOC-ISM-041) in the <u>Resources for</u> <u>Researchers SharePoint</u> to submit with their manuscript to <u>access@ukllc.ac.uk</u>

Data owners have devolved responsibility for review of manuscripts to UK LLC to minimise the time taken to release findings into the public domain. To reduce the length of the methods and acknowledgements sections, data owners have also agreed to be referenced concisely, with more detailed descriptions of their individual LPS samples and acknowledgements provided via supplementary materials (see DOC-ISM-032 on the <u>Resources for Researchers SharePoint</u>).

Please send the **completed checklist**, **your manuscript and lay summary** to <u>access@ukllc.ac.uk</u> for approval **prior** to journal submission with sufficient time for processing. **We expect to process all manuscripts within two weeks of receipt**, but may be able to expedite processing if required. Please note that if there are any substantive changes to the manuscript after UK LLC review, re-review must be sought.

We will review all manuscripts to check that the **publication checklist** is **adhered to**, that all manuscripts fall within the **scope of the approved project**, that all parties are **accurately described** and **acknowledged** and that all **project-specific terms and conditions** have been **adhered to**.

The UK LLC Executive Group may withhold the right to publish any manuscript that threatens to bring UK LLC or any of the contributing data owners into disrepute or which threatens the confidentiality of participants.
